PURPOSE: Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and the Americans with Disabilities Act provides that no otherwise qualified individuals with handicaps shall solely on the basis of their handicap, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program, activity or governmental unit that receives Federal Financial Assistance.

In its intent to comply with the terms of Section 504 and the Americans with Disabilities Act, the City of St. Marys has conducted an evaluation of its buildings and policies. The evaluation was made to determine if any structures contained physical barriers to handicap persons. The evaluation also addressed what the City of St. Marys - adopted policies might prevent handicap persons from fully participating in services, programs, government or employment opportunities.

THE CITY OF ST. MARYS BUILDINGS: The following City-owned buildings are handicap accessible or have limited accessibility based on the time frame when they were constructed:

- 1. City Hall; Sewer Payment Office and Tax Office located at 11 LaFayette Street, St. Marys
- 2. City Police Department located at 319 Erie Avenue, St. Marys
- 3. City Street Department located at Graphite Road, St. Marys
- 4. City Waste Water Treatment Plant located at State Street, St. Marys (the perimeter of outside operating facilities is accessible with paved pathways)
- 5. Benzinger Park located at Fleming Road, St. Marys
- 6. Kaulmont Park located at Hall Avenue, St. Marys
- 7. Memorial Park and Community Pool located on Wolfel Avenue
- 8. Memorial Park Club House
- 9. Luhr Park Building located at Chestnut Street, St. Marys
- 10. Berwind Park located on Berwind Street, St. Marys
- 11. Elk Creek Park located on Depot Street
- 12. City of St. Marys Parking Garage located on Depot Street in St. Marys

PROGRAMS: The City of St. Marys has appointed Ted Polinski, the City's Code Enforcement and Building Inspector, as the City's 504 and ADA Compliance Coordinator. His function, in this capacity, is to keep abreast of all changes in handicap access regulations and to address the needs of handicap persons in gaining access to all City Offices and activities.
