Choose the most appropriate category for the nature of the complaint/concern and provide a brief description of the complaint/concern and citizen's follow up contact information.

This form is to be given to the CDBG Administrator. The CDBG Administrator is to review the issue(s) with the City Manager, if applicable, to determine the actions necessary to resolve the complaint and/or concern as well as determine a timeframe for actions to be completed.

Once a final response is reported on the form, the form is to be signed by the CDBG Administrator and City Manager, if applicable. The original is to be retained in a file in the Community and Economic Development Department.
