PACKAGING INSTRUCTIONS

ELECTRONICS

Electronics should be placed in a cubic yard or Gaylord box which is on a pallet.

All electronics should be weighed before delivery to the Recycling Center. (Weigh the pallet & box first empty then subtract it from the filled weight to determine net weight.

DO NOT overfill the box. Electronics should be level with the top of the box.

PACKAGING INSTRUCTIONS

LAMPS & BATTERIES

All lamps & batteries from businesses should be boxed separately by type and counted or weighed.

Write the quantity/weight of each box on the outside of the box in black marker and make sure the box is securely taped closed.

The terminals of most batteries should be taped for safety. Alkaline Batteries do not need taped with the exception of 6 volt and 9 volt (square) batteries. Make a Delivery Appointment.


