**CAPITAL FUNDS**

**Capital Reserve Fund**

**ENTERPRISE FUNDS:**  
**SEWAGE TREATMENT**  
**FUND**

Mayor Pletcher explained due to the inability of Council to agree on the proposed sewer rates for non-residential customers, the Sewer Committee was proposing another rate structure for non-residential and residential customers.

The following details were provided by Shane Schneider:

Change the Residential Rate to a monthly flat base rate of \$45.50 plus a quarterly surcharge of \$6.80 per thousand gallons of water for above 3,000 gallons of water usage.

Adjustments for certain mixed-use properties – residential portion of property to be billed a monthly flat base rate of \$45.50 plus the corresponding water meter size monthly base rate for non-residential plus a quarterly consumption rate of \$6.80 per thousand gallons of water for above 3,000 gallons of usage for each residential service address on the property.

Non-Residential Rates will have a flat rate based on the corresponding water meter size plus a quarterly consumption rate of \$6.80 per thousand gallons of water usage.

**Motion Passed**

Deputy Mayor Bob Roberts made a motion to accept the proposed changes for the 2022 budget, seconded by Shane Schneider and all were in favor.


